Responsibilities:

- General maintenance work: mowing grass, weeding, watering, shoveling
- Planning and implementing gardens/permaculture/compost-related workshops
- Coordination and delivery of drop-in community gardens programming
- Facilitation of “work parties” or “work bees,”
- Assist with West Broadway community events and act as an ambassador of WBCO in the community

Qualifications and experience:

- Knowledge of gardening and inner city food security issues
- Ability to work outdoors in many types of weather and do physical labour in the gardens
- Ability to lift 40 pounds
- Ability to work well independently - self-directed work habits
- CPR and First Aid training are an asset but not required
- Respectful of all people, good interpersonal skills
- Some experience assisting in the coordination of environmental activities or programs would be an asset

Wage and hours of work:

\$14/ hour; 30 hours/week. Monday to Friday. Occasional evening/weekend work may be required.
