### **Responsibilities:**

- General maintenance work: mowing grass, weeding, watering, shoveling
- Assisting in organizing and hosting workshops
- Coordination and delivery of programming activities (Farmers Market, food hamper delivery, etc)
- Painting, loading and unloading work van, litter pick-up
- Assist with West Broadway community events and act as an ambassador of WBCO in the community

### **Qualifications and experience:**

- Knowledge of gardening and inner city food security issues
- Ability to work outdoors in many types of weather and do physical labour in the gardens
- Ability to lift 40 pounds
- Ability to work well independently - self-directed work habits
- CPR and First Aid training are an asset but not required
- Respectful of all people, good interpersonal skills
- Some experience assisting in the coordination of activities or programs would be an asset

### **Wage and hours of work:**

\$14/ hour; 35 hours/week. Monday to Friday. Occasional evening/weekend work may be required.
